## Design

We can produce panels of any size. The standard height is 1800mm and widths are available in multiples of 300mm. The panels can measure up to 2400x1800mm.

You can also Create-a-Panel where you choose your own combination of material and design.

## Inserts:

The inserts can be made from many different materials some of those available are: five trellis designs, zincalume, coloursteel, plywood, fibre-cement, broom, bamboo, polycarbonate, cloth etc etc. Variations are limited only by your imagination!

Vertical or horizontal trellis and screens are a great style when you need a windbreak but still want to see clearly, they are excellent for fencing pools and decks.

Diagonal trellis is very popular in creating privacy screens, decorative screens, weather screens, fence panels, gate panels and much more.

Square trellis is also great for creating privacy, or fencing off areas. Trellis looks great painted a colour to suit your home.

We use New Zealand “plantation grown renewable resource” *Pinus radiata*, with the option of three treatment systems. The treatment options run from interior use right through to use in the marine environment.

“My Precious” Panels aim to provide the consumer with the largest possible range and choice while the distributor has less stock holding and handling. The tops and bases are sold separately; for example a store could stock 5 tops and 11 bases (16 items to stock), however the consumer has 55 different combinations to choose from.
